Team NB Coach Selection Process

Step one – Review or Previous Year's Coaches (Target date by July 31)

- 1. The Technical Director, after consideration¹ of previous coaching history with Team NB, invites previous Team NB coaches for a return engagement.
- 2. Coaches submit applications.
- 3. Technical Department reviews applications and prepares recommendations for team assignments.
- 4. Technical Department reviews coaching assignments with the Director of Coaching.
- 5. (Team NB assignment are made and communicated to the selected coaches and Board of Directors.

If a shortfall of coaches occurs, vacant positions may be filled by following step 2.

Step two: Additional Coach Requirements – phase 1.

- 6. Posting of coaching opportunities via the Soccer NB website and/or mass e-mail distribution. (August 15th)
- 7. All applications are reviewed by the Technical department and the Director of coaching (selection committee). Submission of an application does not guarantee selection even if coaching positions are vacant.
- 8. The selection committee will conduct interviews if necessary. (TD; HP Coach; Director of Coaching).
- 9. Team NB assignment are made and communicated to the selected coaches and Board of Directors.

If a shortfall of coaches occurs, vacant positions may be filled by following step 3.

Step three: Additional Coach Requirements – phase 2. (Mid Sept.)

- 10. Direct contact with suitable and qualified coaches.
- 11. Technical Department reviews coaching assignments with the Director of Coaching.
- 12. Team NB assignment are made and communicated to the selected coaches and Board of Directors.

Considerations:

- Review of notes regarding coaching performance from previous years (records should be kept)
 - ✓ Concerns from players, parents, peers, disciplinary reports
 - ✓ Review by Technical Department
 - Completion of all requirements from previous season (reports, player evaluations criminal record checks)
- Coaches should not be participate with the same group of players for more than two years
- > Participation of the coach in the coaching development activities would be an asset.
- Consider using a committee to review applications and prepare the final selection final assignment decision rests with the Director of Technical Development

Nature of Commitment

- > All Head and Assistant coaches are required and responsible for:
 - Work according to the LTPD work plan set by SNB Technical Department.
 - Be part of a dynamic team to supporting the overall philosophy of Team NB.
 - Return all required reports to SNB Technical Department (Players evaluations, Camps and tournament reports, attendance records, etc,...).
 - Participate in the scouting, evaluation and selection process during the regional ID Camps.
 - Coach in the Regional Academy Program.
 - Coach in the Winter Training Program.
 - Participate in the showcase Tours with their teams US or Canada (May –June).
 - Spring Training Program 1 weekend per month April/May/June.
 - Participate in the preparation camp weekend (2 ½ to 3 days).
 - Participate in Atlantic Tournament.
 - Be responsible for all training kits (uniforms and team equipment).
 - Be responsible for supervision of the players during all Camps and tournaments.

Required Knowledge and Experience

- All Head Coaches must have a minimum of Provincial B license to coach at the All-Star level and having a National B is an asset.
- The Assistant Coach must have the CSA PRE-B license and be committed to achieving the next level in the license program.

Soccer New Brunswick will consider any applicant who is in the process of completing their CSA Provincial B license with the current provincial cycle.

All potential candidates for these coaching positions should:

- > Provide the required *criminal record check* with this application.
- > Be in good standing with Soccer New Brunswick and associated programs.
- > Be knowledgeable in the Long Term Development Program.

Be prepared to establish and maintain fluent working relationships with all Regional Academy Head Coaches

Preference may be given to:

- Coaches with a good history with Soccer New Brunswick Teams and clubs.
- Bilingual coaches (French and English).

Please note: Part of Team NB development pathway, Head coach will be allowed to coach one team for a maximum of 2 seasons.
