The coach will provide a support role in Soccer NB's (SNB) efforts to:

- Increase number of New Brunswick (NB) Train to Compete athletes achieving success at the national level
- Increase number of NB Train to Train athletes achieving success at the Regional (Eastern Canada) and national level
- Increase number of NB athletes in the Train to Train and Train to Compete stages of development as demonstrated by increased number of entries in appropriate competitions.
- Increase alignment of athlete development pathways with the long-term player development plans.
- Increase number of positive coach mentoring experiences
- To develop each HP Academy player to his or her maximum potential and to have NB players recognized by the Canadian National Team Program
- Achieve the High performance Academy goals

The Coach will:

- Work according to the Long Term Player Development (LTPD) work plan set by SNB Technical Department.
- Be part of a dynamic team to supporting the overall philosophy of Team NB.
