2. GENERAL

2.1. Any Member which is not registered with Soccer New Brunswick or has not paid its registration fees shall have all privileges suspended, including, if applicable, the right to host or to participate in provincial championships.

3. REGULAR MEMBERSHIP FEES

- 3.1. All Fees are payable seven (7) days after the closing of registration which will normally be June 30th for the summer season and January 15th for the winter (indoor) season.
- 3.2. Notwithstanding article 3.1, Regular Members that have more than 300 registered players shall pay 50% of the previous year's registration dues by June 1st of the current year. The balance owing shall be due in accordance with Rule 3.1

3.3. Player Registration Fees

3.3.1. Player registration are considered annual fees for the Period of March 1st through April 30th.
